Open Enrollment Information

CRPUSD's Open Enrollment period will be August 21, 2023 - September 15, 2023. As a reminder, Open Enrollment is when all employees renew their health insurance, as well as have the opportunity to to change benefit plans if desired. We wanted to share the 2023-2024 Insurance Rate sheets for those of you that would like to begin planning for Open Enrollment (please see attached rate sheets by unit). The new rates will begin on October 1, 2023 and provide coverage until September 30, 2024.
